As part of their educational programme we are proposing to take a number of students in Year 10 to the Playhouse Theatre to see a performance of an Inspector Calls. The purpose of this visit is to enhance student's understanding of the play by J B Priestley. For students to visualise the dramatic form of a GCSE text and to give them an opportunity to form various interpretations of the dramatic techniques used by directors when performing a play. The organizer for this visit will be Ms Bhamji to whom any enquiries should be directed. The required contribution for this trip is £36.80 which covers the cost of the theatre ticket and return coach travel.

We will be going by coach and students should meet in the KS3 car park at 5:10pm. We expect to be back at school by 10.45 – 11.00pm approximately.

As we will be returning quite late please ensure that your child is collected from the KS3 car park on our return to school.

They must NEVER go away on their own and they will be given clear information about where to contact a member of staff if any problems arise during the visit.
