You will have three compulsory exam papers at the end of Year 12 assessed internally:

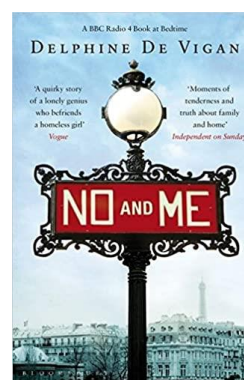
- Listening, reading and translation, 1.45 hours, 64 marks, 40% of your total mark.
- Written response to works and translation, 1.40 hours, 60 marks, 30% of your total mark.
- Speaking, 15 minutes, 74 marks, 30% of your total mark.
