## Re: Sixth Form Taster Day and Progression Evening - Tuesday 10th December 2024

#### Taster Day 2024

- Students will be asked to complete a survey indicating their preference of subject choices w/b 18.11.24
- Students should come to school in smart dress, see below for expected standard
- All students MUST wear their lanyards around their necks all day as usual
- Year 11 students will register as normal with their tutors please be punctual, so 8.30am as usual
- P1 meeting in KS4 hall led by sixth form team
- Periods 2, 3 and 4 A level/level 3 taster lessons students will receive personalised timetables before the day in registration time
- Early close for whole school at 1.30pm to prepare for Sixth Form Open Evening, which follows from 3.30pm 6.30pm (talk in the ks3 hall at 5pm).

# **Progression Evening 2024**

- Student should return to school for the progression evening in school uniform/smart dress and that they must sign in on arrival with their parent/carer
- All students and parents/ carers should access the event via the KS3 Lower site (access via Woodford Avenue); parking in the school is not available
- All sixth form departments will be represented at the evening (3:30pm-6:30pm), with staff and current sixth formers available at stalls to advise and answer any questions you/your child may have
- A talk will be delivered in the KS3 hall at 5pm (the presentation will be recorded and made available on the school website following the event).
