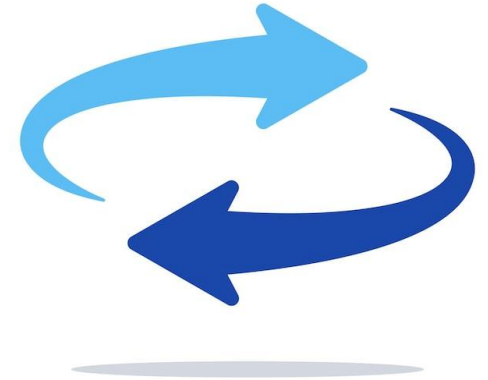

- This outlines the students' strengths, weaknesses and a list of suggested strategies to help support them in lessons.
- All teachers will have access to these in school and able to use this to help plan lessons and produce an additional resources that might be needed.

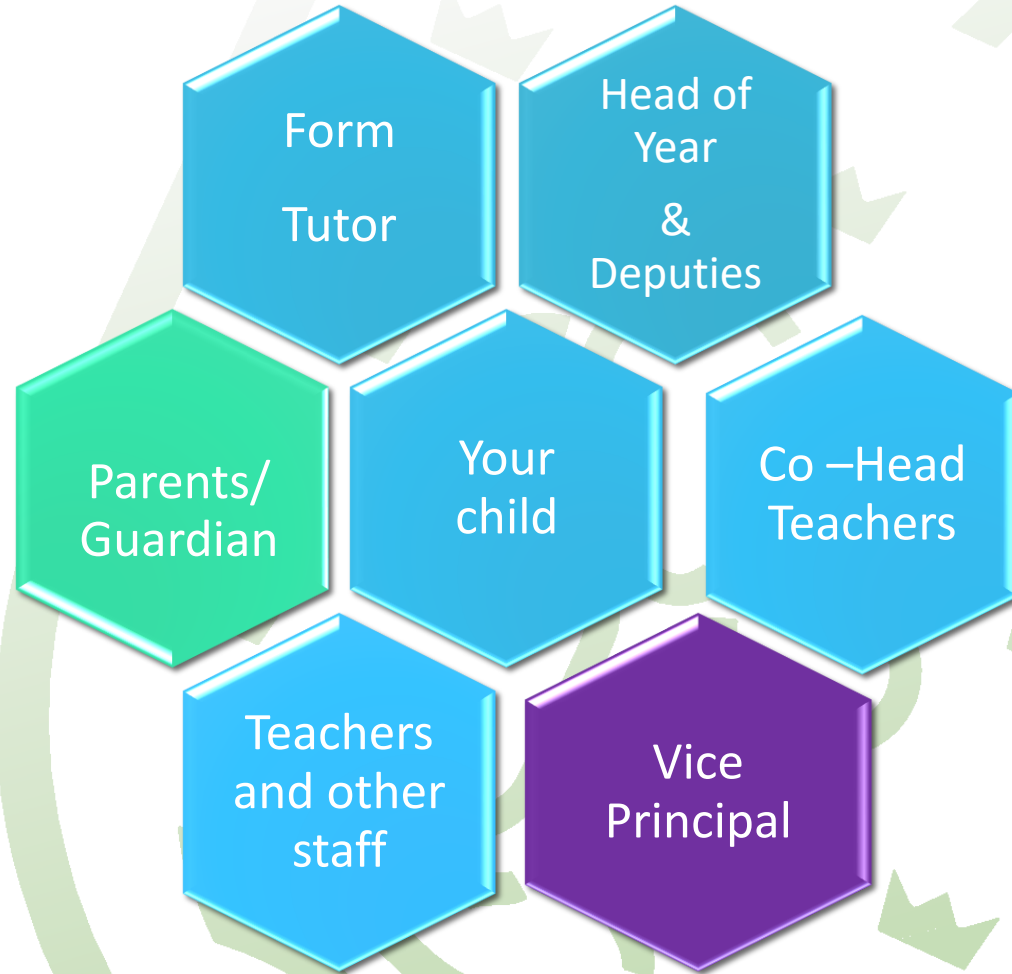
Outside professionals: SEaTSS, Little Heath, SALT, New Rush Hall, OT....

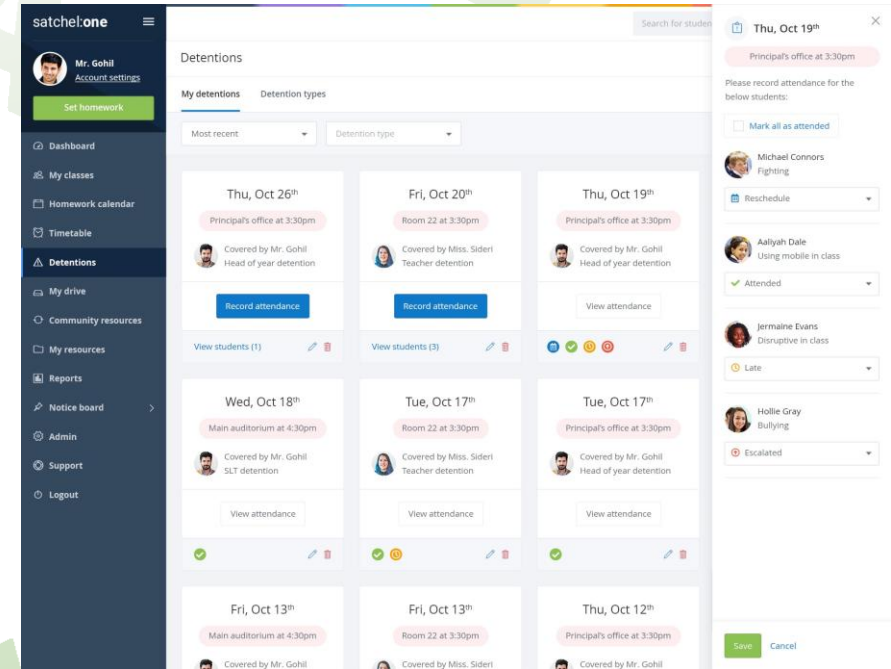

This can be used as a good method to motivate your child.

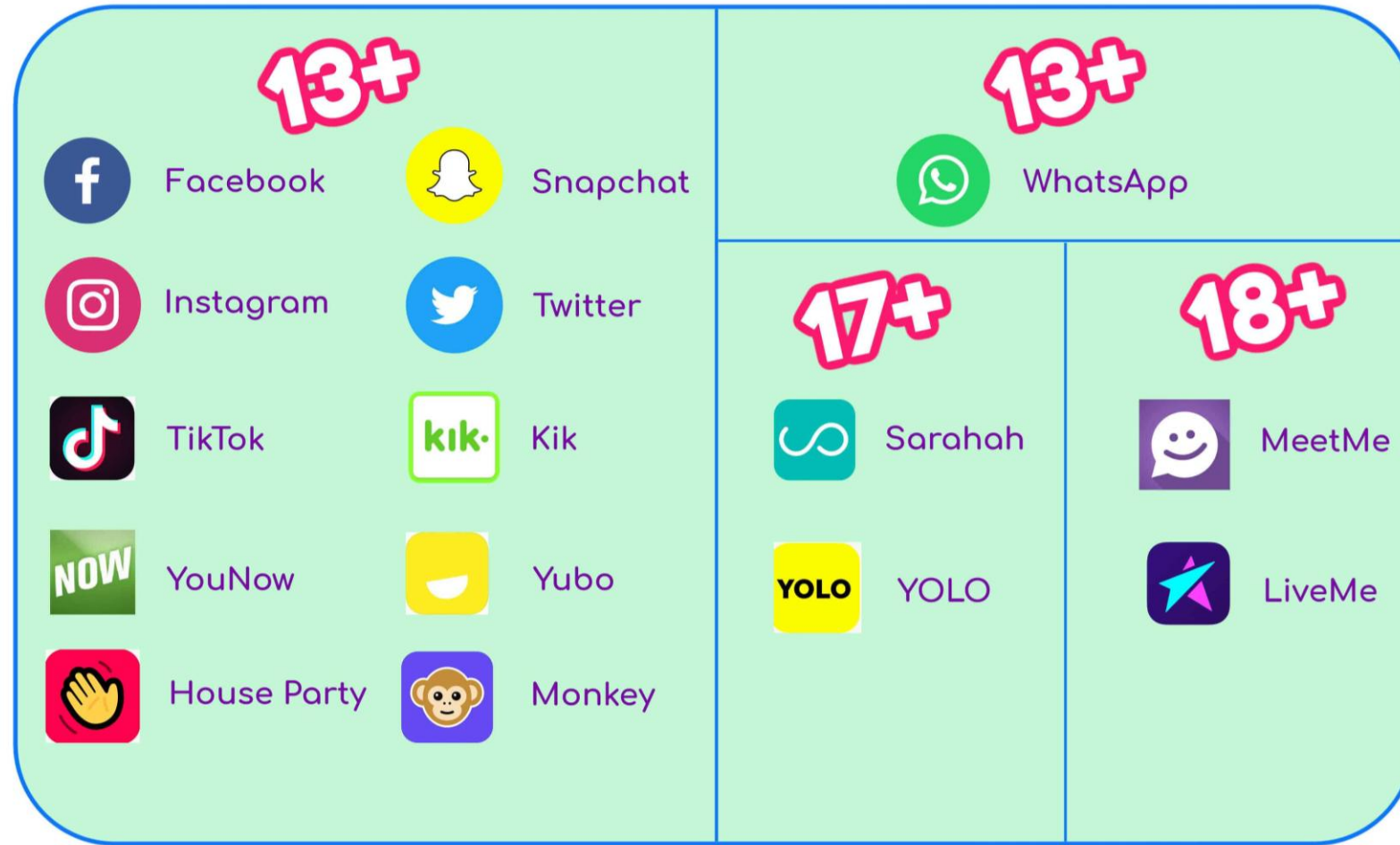
HONOUR ROLL

This can be for academic progress, personal growth, a good deed, extra curricular success etc...

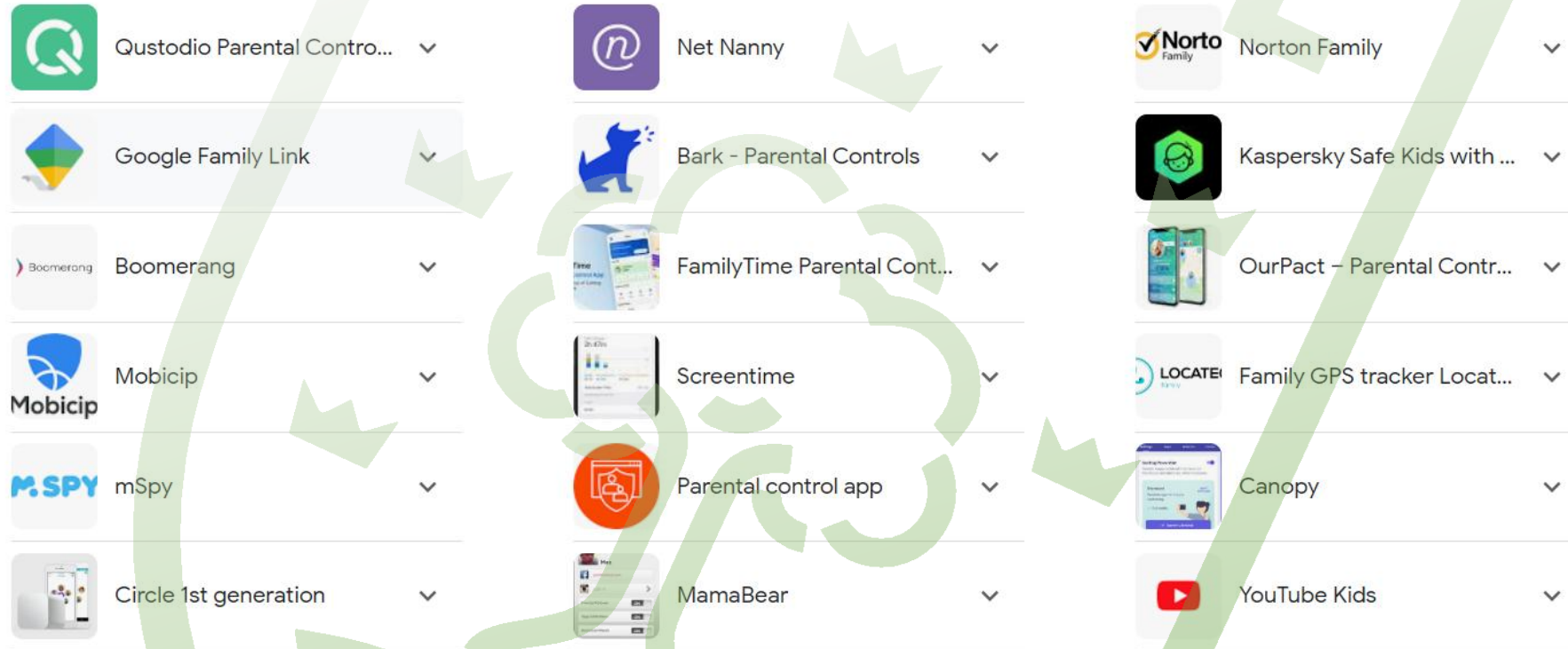
The winning pupil will be added to our Year 7 Honour Roll.

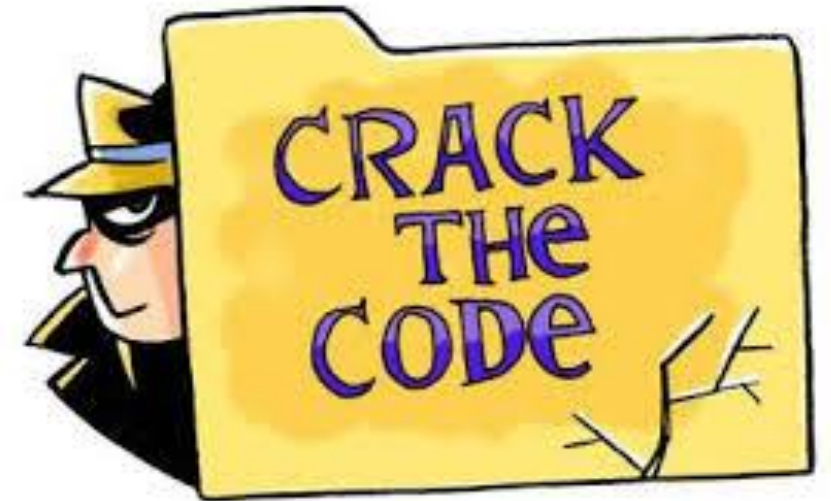
English:
