



GCSE Results 2026

Beal High School students celebrate another year of exceptional achievement, with 100% of students securing a progression route into post-16 study.

82% achieved a grade 4+ in both English and Maths

61% achieved a 5+ in English and maths

Subjects and pathways that shone:

- **Maths** students achieved **40% grade 7 or above** across the whole year group.
- **85% of students achieved a grade 4 or above in English Literature**, with 25% of students achieving grade 7 or above.
- 60% of students achieved 5+ in science
- 35% of all students in the cohort achieved a grade 7+ in a **Science**.
- **Triple Science** delivered **100% grade 5 or above** in Biology, Chemistry and Physics, with **75% grade 7+** or above in Chemistry and Physics.
- **Religious Studies** achieved **89% grade 4 or above, with 50% at grade 7 or above**.
- 75% of students studying **3D Design** achieved 5+ and 84% of students studying **Food Preparation and Nutrition** achieved a 5+. 46% of students studying Food Prep and Nutrition achieved a grade 7+.
